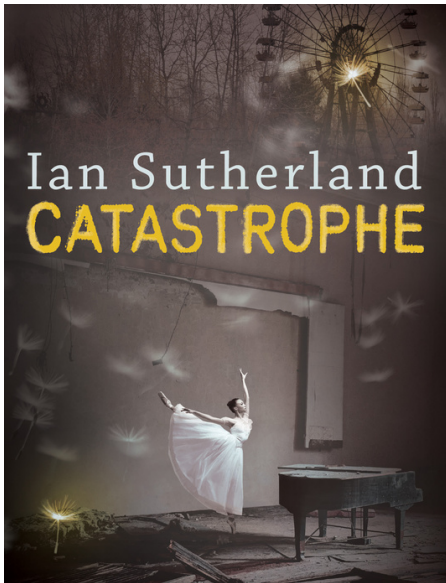

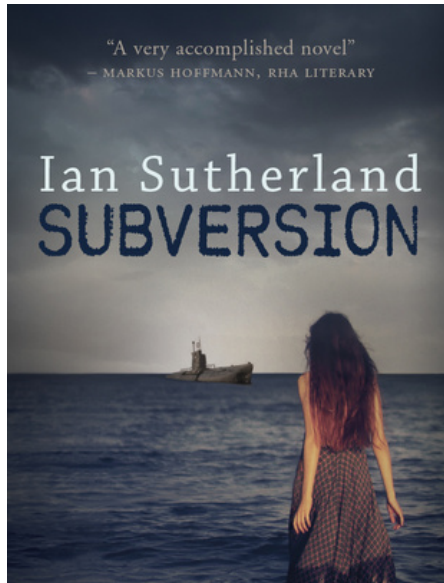


CATASTROPHE
